Greetings!

Successful education is collaboration between school and parents. In keeping with its mission and philosophy, GDGPS, Indirapuram works in close partnership with the parent community for achieving positive impact on students’ motivation, engagement, behaviour, and academic and social outcomes. As collaborative efforts help to foster optimism, we request the parents to note down the following points and seek your support so that desired goals can be accomplished by working together.

**1) Regularity and Punctuality:**

- Kindly ensure the regularity and punctuality of your ward. Taking leaves during working days is strongly discouraged as it leads to academic loss. In case the child is not medically fit to attend the school, then it is advisable to have proper care and rest at home. Half day leave on pretext of any reason will not be permitted. Students arriving late will not be allowed to enter the school. Kindly note the reporting time.

**2) Code of Conduct & Uniform:**

- Motivate your child to maintain a proper code of conduct as any misbehaviour /indiscipline and damage to school property may lead to serious consequence (disciplinary action).
- While your ward leaves the home for school, kindly ensure that he/she is dressed in neat and well- ironed school uniform. Boys with short and decent hair cut and girls with plaits or pony tails as the case may be, with their nails trimmed. Nail art, Mehendi, Tattoo etc. are strictly not permitted.

**3) Communication & Regular Interaction:**

- We welcome parents’ feedback and constructive criticism as we believe that the communication is vital to ensuring that our school continues to meet the needs of our students as well as those of their parents.
- Kindly ensure that you are regular in touch with the school as we believe in **direct interaction /dialogue with parents only and not their guardian**, for matters related to Academic performance / Behavioural issues & any other administrative requirements of child to prevent any misunderstanding. Keep yourself updated about school activities & other information, keep track of the performance of your ward and also visit the school during PTM and whenever informed by the teacher to report.
