Highlight of Book Week Activities:

Day 1-Author Interaction Session - Don't miss the chance to meet Ms. Vaijanti Savant Tonpe, learn about her literary journey, and get insights into the writing and publishing world.

A. Book-to-Life(1 to 3): Costume Extravaganza - Students are invited to dress as their favourite literary characters. This will be a great opportunity for a fun parade or fashion show creating a fun and vibrant atmosphere.

Rules:

- -Costumes should represent characters from books .
- -Props according to the character
- -Originality and creativity will be considered during judging.
- -When you parade your costume, we'd love you to share a few lines about your character. Tell us who they are, a key moment from their story, or even deliver a memorable quote. This will help everyone understand the context of your costume and make the character come alive!
- **B. Narrative Battles (11 & 12)** Students will share their best stories and transport the listeners to another world, enhancing their storytelling skills.

Rules:

- No. of participants 2 students in a team

- One entry per school
- -Participants may choose any story to tell but should keep it appropriate for all audiences.
- -Stories should be told without reading from a script or book.
- -Time limits will be enforced (3-4 minutes per storyteller).
- -Judges will assess storytelling skills, including voice modulation, expression, and engagement of the audience.

Day2- Book Buffet: Story time snacks (6-8)- Menu Planning: Develop a menu inspired by the books or literary themes being showcased at each table. Consider incorporating dishes mentioned in the books, foods that represent characters or settings, or thematic snacks and beverages.

Rules:

- No. of participants 2 students in a team
- One entry per school
- Decoration of stall as per the theme
- Prepare the food and beverages for the banquet.
- Students can dress up according to the theme

Day 3-Literary Snippets:Speedy Book Insights (Classes 9 & 10) - Students will have the chance to share their favourite books through short presentations as PPT, potentially inspiring their classmates to explore new stories.

Rules:

- No. of participants 2 students in a team
- One entry per school
- -Each presentation should be concise (e.g., 3-5 minutes).
- -Presentations should include a summary of the book, the student's opinion or review, and reasons why others should read it.
- **Day 4- Plot Creation Competition: Creative Narrative Contest** (4 & 5) By organizing a Creative Narrative Contest, we provide students with an opportunity to unleash their imagination, develop their writing skills, and share their unique stories with others in the school community.

Rules:

- Theme will be given on the spot
- Story idea should be original & unique
- Share a softcopy of the story as per the instructions
- One entry per school
